Two \$1,000 scholarships are being awarded this year. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Americans of Italian lineage (at least one Italian grandparent)
- High school seniors graduating in 2010 and who will be pursuing a college education immediately following graduation
- Residents of Monroe County
- Maintain a GPA of 85% or above
- Two years of Italian in High School or must have the equivalent knowledge of the Italian language (equivalency will be determined by a brief interview)
- Complete and submit the scholarship application by May 16, 2010

All applicants will be notified of their status. There is no application fee. Now is the time to show us your talent, character and desire, and complete the application with the pride of your heritage.

The Scholarship Committee requests that a representative of the Italian Civic League be present at the recipient's high school, at the time when the school holds its awards assembly, in order to make the scholarship presentation.

The scholarship recipients will be recognized at a special luncheon to be held on Columbus Day 2010.
